Director of Clinical Education at Saint Louis University, Program in Physical Therapy, with input from faculty, de a process to convert clinical instructors' student CPI results to a numeric score. These numeric CPI scores serve as the outcomes of SLO#1 and SLO#2.

The Director of Clinical Education at Saint Louis University, Program in Physical Therapy assisted in identifying releval CPI items for assessment of Stand SL@2. Items from the CPI were chosen due to their close match of the intended learning outcome and assessment method. For example, CPI item #4 is designed to assess if student physic therapist's communication meets the needs of the situation.

The 3 courses chosen for assessment o#\$Land SL@ 2 (DPT 5291 Clinical Experience IA; DPT 6192 Clinical Experience IIB; DPT 6294 Clinical Experience IV) represent a sequence of clinical education courses wherein studen are expected to incrementally develop from beginner to entry level physical therapist while carrying a full caseload.

The assessment rubric was developed with assistance from the Director of Clinical Education, taking into account the developmental nature of the clinical experience courses.
