The program has three main methods of evaluation. One method is through yearly advisor review meetings. The student reports all of their accomplishments and benchmarks of the program in their annual advisor document. The second assessment method is using Foliotek, a portfolio that tracks the student completing benchmarks in core program goals and learning objectives. There are specific assignments tied to each Foliotek section. Third, the first year Personal and Professional Development Evaluation (PREDE) are replaced by the 360 evaluation. This is a full evaluation of the student's coursework, clinical skills, and professional feedback from other faculty.
