Our results show that our students are doing very well meeting expectations with regards to scientific communication and lab research objectives. No specific actions need to be taken.

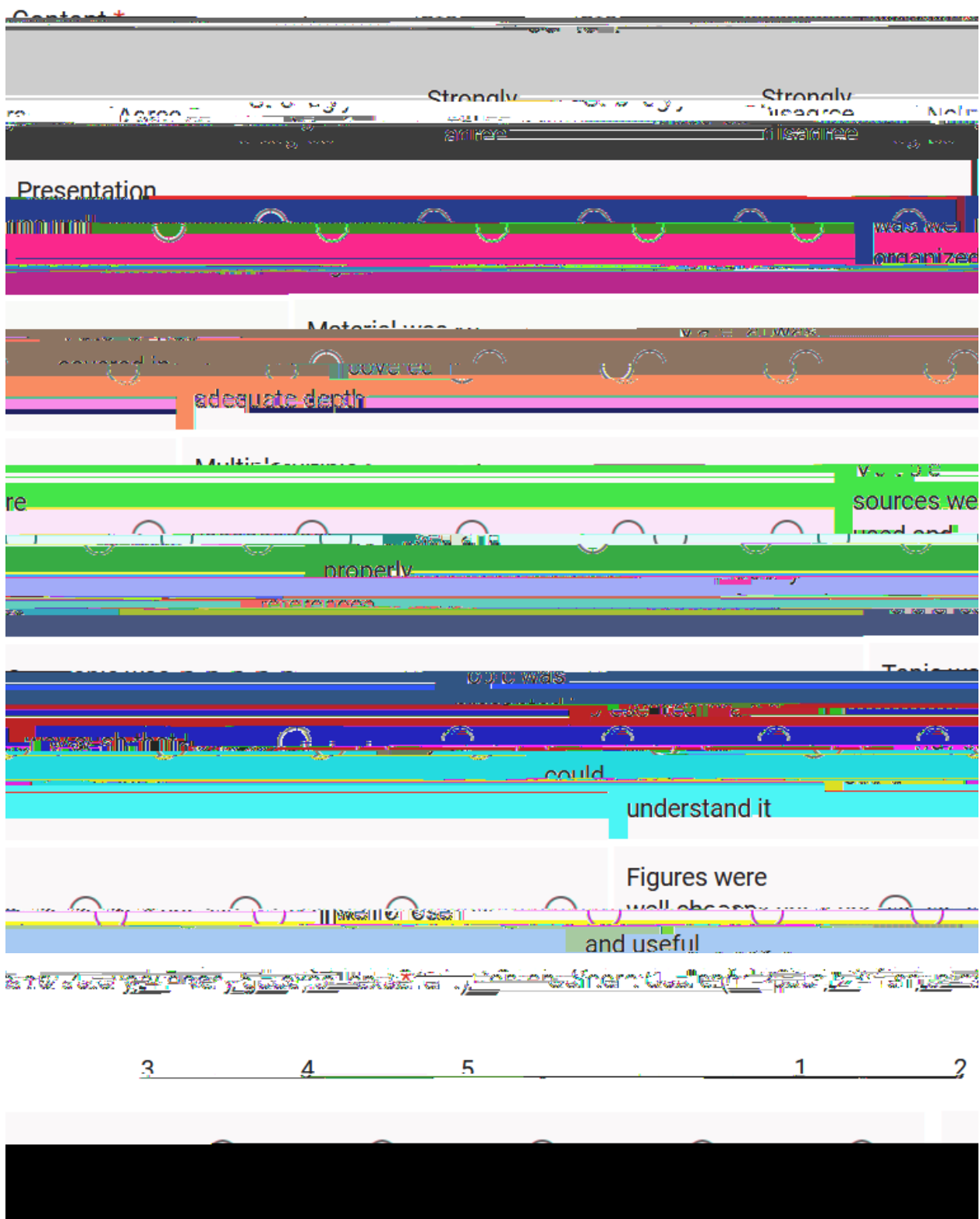
7. Closing the Loop: Review of Previous Assessment Findings and Changes
